The FST and SSP have agreed the following rates for the FST/SSP Agreement for the Commissioning of a Play:

For a Full Length Play:

Future Review:

The FST and SSP further agree that we will work together to review the Minimum Terms Agreement, with a view to bringing a revised Agreement to our respective members in June 2019. FST members have agreed a further 2.5% on the rates for commissioning a new play, conditional on FST and SSP reaching agreement on a revised Minimum Terms Agreement.

For the future, we are committed to working together in advocating for a healthy whole ecosystem for Scottish theatre in general and new writing in particular, as a key part of that ecosystem. The intent remains that, depending on the economic climate within the sector at the point of review, future increases will be at least in line with inflation, if deemed appropriate in the overall context.
