**Future Review:**

The FST and SSP further agree that we will meet in early 2018, once the Creative Scotland RFO outcomes are known, with a view to making an agreement for 2018/19 before the end of March 2018. We agree to explore the potential for a multi-year agreement at that time, and also agree that, if possible, we will seek to agree future rates to align with future funding bid processes. The intent remains that, depending on the economic climate within the sector at the point of review, future increases will be at least in line with inflation, if deemed appropriate in the overall context.
